MINUTES

A. CALL TO ORDER

John Sharp called the meeting to order at 9:05 a.m. He introduced himself and entertained introductions of members, staff, and guests.

B. APPROVAL OF THE FEBRUARY 8, 2022, MINUTES

David Riesland moved to approve the February 8, 2022, minutes. Petya Stefanoff seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

C. ACTION ITEM:

1. Requested change to FY 2018 Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) Project Funding

Hannah Nolen informed the Committee that the City of Del City changed their priorities and decided not to use the \$240,000 in TAP funding that was awarded to them. It was recommended that the first backup project from the 2017 approved TAP project listing, Norman's Flood Avenue-Tecumseh Road Multimodal Path from Robinson Street to 24th Avenue NW, receive the funding. This project is on target to be able to meet the deadline of September 30, 2023, so the funding can remain in the ACOG MPO region.

Jan Fees moved to recommend the ACOG MPO Policy Committee approve moving \$240,000 in additional funds to the City of Norman's Flood Avenue Project. Josh Vaught seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

D. FOR INFORMATION ONLY:

1. ODOT Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) Project Awards

John Sharp highlighted the information as detailed in the agenda memorandum. He referred to the table that listed the ODOT TAP Awards in the ACOG Transportation Management Area (TMA).

2. 2023 Bike Month in Central Oklahoma

Hannah Nolen said Bike Month is in May and then highlighted the information as detailed in the agenda memorandum. She encouraged the committee to look at the ACOG website for more information about Bike Month and said ACOG is available to assist the entities in planning and creating promotional materials for Bike to Work Day events.

3. Bicycle and Pedestrian Related Bills Introduced in the 2023 Oklahoma Legislature

Jennifer Sebesta gave updates on the various bills. She said SB 306, HB 1330, HB 2099 all failed. Ms. Sebesta said HB 2752 is moving forward, and this bill is being pushed by ODOT. She said this bill appears to remove right-of-way for pedestrians. John Sharp said ACOG could possibly suggest amendments to the bill by adding additional clarifications.

4. Status of Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) Projects in ACOG MPO Transportation Management Area (TMA)

Hannah Nolen highlighted the information provided in the agenda memorandum. She provided a detailed status report to the committee.

E. NEW BUSINESS

Chuck Mikkelson with Oklahoma City Running Club said the Greenway Trail is almost open.

John Sharp said ODOT is applying for a grant to redo the bridge across the river and take down the old bridge on I-35 and put up a new bridge. Mr. Sharp said they also

talked about having bike pedestrian bridges associated with that. Mr. Sharp said this will be a monster job for ODOT.

INFORMATION:

ACOG is continuing its Air Quality Small Grant Program with a FY 2024 Call for Projects this fall. This grant program strives to reduce transportation emissions and improve air quality in Central Oklahoma by funding small infrastructure projects and congestion relief efforts.

These small grants, to be no less than \$50,000, will serve to meet the goals of the federal Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) Improvement Program and/or Carbon Reduction Program (CRP) by relieving congestion, reducing emissions, and improving air quality. Two years each of CMAQ and CRP funds will be available during this Call for Projects, representing approximately \$4 million total.
