#### **INFORMATION:**

Bikewalkokc, Oklahoma City's first bicycle and pedestrian plan, was adopted in 2018. It was an ambitious attempt to upgrade the city's bikeability and walkability. Since its adoption, Oklahoma City has seen 176 miles of new sidewalks and 9.5 miles of new bike lanes added to its streets, with much more in design. The 2023 update of bikewalkokc builds upon the success of that plan by more than doubling the number of sidewalks called for in the original plan. It also reprioritizes the bike and trail network to focus on adding connectivity to the core network now on the ground or in design. The plan emphasizes safety as a first priority, calling for the city to try new and innovative designs with regards to its bicycle and pedestrian networks.
