D. NEW BUSINESS

Shelby Templin with ODOT gave an update on the ODOT Active Transportation Plan. She said they are going to have an online virtual meeting on August 23, at 10:30 a.m. They will not be presenting the entire plan but an extensive overview. Ms. Templin stated the plan is a guidance document not a list of projects. They will go out for public comments at the end of September. Ms. Templin said in June ODOT held a public unveiling of the Bike Route 66 sign in Tulsa. There is also going to be a similar unveiling in Oklahoma City. This is also her last meeting because she is leaving ODOT.

Bonnie Winslow with Oklahoma Bicycle Society said October 13 & 14 is the biennial Bicycle Summit, which will be held at Rose State College in Midwest City. This is a two-day event, the first day is for professional transportation officials, and the second day is geared towards advocates and cyclists.

INFORMATION:

On January 31, 2023, ACOG was awarded a \$192,000 Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) federal grant to develop a safety action plan. ACOG will contribute \$48,000 in funds as a 20 percent match for this \$240,000 project. A Regional Safety Action Plan is a vital endeavor for Central Oklahoma. By establishing a framework, identifying priority areas, and implementing evidence-based strategies, ACOG aims to reduce crashes, injuries, and fatalities, ultimately ensuring the safety and well-being for Central Oklahomans.

On August 1, 2023, ACOG released a Request for Proposals (RFP) for a consultant to develop a Regional Safety Action Plan (RSAP) for Central Oklahoma. ACOG was seeking proposals from qualified and experienced firms to collect, produce, and analyze information to create the RSAP for the ACOG Transportation Management Area (TMA).

Three prospective firms responded to the RFP with detailed proposals, which were reviewed by ACOG staff for pricing and thoroughness. Upon final assessment, <u>Kimley-Horn</u> (consultant overview) was determined to have the best proposal and was chosen for the project at the September ACOG Board of Directors meeting.

The total cost for the ACOG RSAP project is \$240,000 and will take approximately 12 months to complete.

The month of October is designated as National Pedestrian Safety Awareness Month by the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) and the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA). ACOG is planning a series of events and messaging campaigns to help raise awareness in Central Oklahoma.

Walk to School Day took place on October 4, 2023. This was a day where students and parents were encouraged to try walking to school as a means of transportation, while also increasing awareness of safety around school zones and school buses. Schools can still hold Walk to School Days throughout the rest of October.

On October 12, ACOG will be hosting a documentary viewing of The Street Project, a film highlighting the serious issue of rising pedestrian and bicyclist deaths on American streets and roads. This viewing will be followed by a panel discussion on the issue with a focus on Central Oklahoma. This event will take place at the 46th Star Auditorium in the Downtown Oklahoma City Library (from 6:00 pm to 7:30 pm).
