# MINUTES

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## A. CALL TO ORDER

Chairperson Brian Grider called the meeting to order at 1:20 p.m. A quorum was present. He welcomed all in attendance.

## B. APPROVAL OF THE JANUARY 25, 2024 MINUTES

Councilmember David Bennett moved to approve the January 25, 2024, minutes. Trustee Glenn Berglan seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

## C. CONSENT DOCKET: *For Information Only*

1. Preparation of CY 2023 Network Monitoring Report: Lauren Woods, Transportation Planning Services (TPS) Transportation Planner II – Performance

Mayor Phil Freeman moved to approve that all items under the Consent Docket be considered in one vote. Councilmember David Bennett seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

## D. REGULAR AGENDA ITEMS THAT MAY REQUIRE ACOG MPO POLICY COMMITTEE ACTION

1. Selection of FY 2024 ACOG Public Fleet Air Grants Projects: David Frick, AICP, TPS Air Quality & Clean Cities Planner II

John Sharp, filling in for David Frick, highlighted the information provided in the agenda memorandum to the committee. Mr. Sharp said ACOG was able to fully fund all the applications for the FY 2024 ACOG Public Fleet Clean Air Grants projects. Oklahoma County was able to adjust their project to a more manageable scope, keeping the projects under the funding cap, allowing the City of Edmond was able to increase their request to five level 2 chargers.

Mayor Matt Dukes made a motion to approve the nine projects listed on the next page for funding (\$4,286,415.00), utilizing CMAQ funds allocated to ACOG's Public Fleet Conversion Grant (CLEAN AIR Grants) Program, and move the remaining funds (\$68,947.00) to the next round of ACOG Public Fleet Conversion Grant (CLEAN AIR Grants) Program. Councilmember Peter Hoffman seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

2. Safety Performance Measures Trends and Targets for CY 2024: Lauren Wood, TPS Transportation Planner II

Lauren Wood highlighted the information provided in the agenda memorandum. Ms. Wood said based upon the information provided to ACOG about the performance measures, ACOG recommends supporting ODOT's CY 2024 safety targets for all five safety performance measures.

Trustee Glen Berglan made a motion to approve the selected safety targets options and submit the same to ODOT. Councilmember David Bennett seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

3. Proposed Amendment to the FY 2024 Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP) Budget:

Jennifer Sebesta, TPS Division Manager.

Jennifer Sebesta highlighted the information as detailed in the agenda memorandum. She said it is difficult for ACOG to provide a local match with these funds, so passing it through to the transit agencies allows these funds to be utilized.

Mayor Peter Hoffman made a motion to the proposed FY 2024 UPWP budget amendment to include an additional \$400,000 in FTA Section 5303 funds, for a total grant amount of \$600,000, for the MAPS 4 Transit Planned Growth - Long Range Plan. Mayor Phil Freeman seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

4. Transportation News and Update Report: John Sharp, Deputy Director *For information only.*

**Climate Pollution Reduction Grant**

Mr. Sharp said the Priority Climate Action Plan (PCAP) is due tomorrow to EPA. There will be more information on this item at the ACOG Board meeting.

**Federal Highway Administration (FHWA)**

ACOG staff attended an FHWA access management training this month. The training focused on safety issues and traffic flow. Mr. Sharp said several cities sent their staff also.

**Surface Transportation Block Grant Funding**

Mr. Sharp said ACOG is reviewing application corrections that have been requested for this grant. ACOG's plan is to bring it to the committees in March or April.

**FY 2025 Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP)**

This month, ACOG started meeting with local partners to coordinate tasks for FY 2025. ACOG discussed tasks that will be completed in FY 2024, what needs to be carried over, and new tasks for FY 2025.

**Santa Fe Station**

Earlier this month ACOG met with Oklahoma City, the Regional Transportation Authority (RTA), and consultant Kimley Horn to discuss future transit related plans for the Santa Fe Station and the new arena. Different options were discussed and evaluated based on the available space and level of transit service that might be needed.

**MPO Quarterly Coordination Meeting**

A meeting was held this month to discuss a number of items including safety performance targets, audits, and functional class updates. ODOT will be starting on their next long-range transportation plan soon and INCOG and ACOG provided some suggestions.

**Regional Safety Summit**

Oklahoma City and ACOG hosted this event at the Ronald J. Norick Downtown Library. Seveny people attended the event, which was kicked off by Mayor Davis from Edmond. There were several elected officials including five ACOG Board members, FHWA staff, and state agencies in attendance. There were several interactive exercises and a panel discussion over various safety concerns and possible solutions. ACOG, Oklahoma City, and Guthrie will be working on Safety Action Plans over the course of this year. This will allow our communities to apply for safety implementation grants in the near future.

**INFORMATION:**

ACOG continues to work with consultant Kimley-Horn on the development of a Regional Safety Action Plan (RSAP). By establishing this framework, identifying priority areas, and implementing evidence-based strategies, ACOG aims to reduce crashes, injuries, and fatalities, ultimately ensuring the safety and well-being of Central Oklahomans.

As part of the development of the RSAP, ACOG and the City of Oklahoma City held a Regional Safety Summit on Wednesday, February 28, 2024, at the Ronald J. Norick Downtown Library. This collaborative summit was a chance to engage community leadership, elected officials, and other stakeholders to discuss transportation safety through policy, education, and infrastructure. The agenda featured a morning presentation, ACOG and Oklahoma City focused breakout sessions, and an afternoon panel discussion.

This spring, the consulting team will be implementing a robust public engagement plan, involving a project-specific website, community pop-up events, online surveys, and public workshops.
