INFORMATION:

On November 15, 2021, the Federal Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA) was signed into law. This bill increased the amount of Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) funding for states and Metropolitan Planning Organizations (MPOs) by nearly 70 percent over a 5-year period.

The ACOG TAP intends to provide funding for projects that advance non-motorized transportation opportunities in the Central Oklahoma region. This includes projects such as pedestrian and bicycle facilities, recreational trails, safe routes to school projects, and more. TAP continues to build upon the legacy of the Transportation Enhancements and Safe Routes to Schools programs by providing funding opportunities for local projects that support additional transportation options, strengthen local economies, improve quality of life, protect the natural environment, and enhance transportation infrastructure.

A Call for Projects (CFP) was last held in FY 2023 with \$7.5 million available for projects in the ACOG Adjusted Urbanized Area (UZA). The CFP was held from September 1, 2022, through October 31, 2022. As a result, nine projects were awarded at a total of \$7,487,454. The remaining \$12,546 in addition to 3 years of funding will be available for the FY 2025 ACOG TAP CFP.

At the April meeting, in anticipation of the FY 2025 CFP, ACOG staff will accept suggestions from this committee regarding changes to both the ACOG TAP scoring criteria and program guidance. Any changes will need to be voted on and approved by the ACOG MPO Policy Committee at their June meeting in advance of the CFP in the fall. ACOG continues to provide information to members and committees on available grants in Central Oklahoma. Below is information on a few open grant opportunities in the region.

Active Transportation Infrastructure Investment Program (ATIIP) – Federal Highway Administration

- This grant program was created to plan, design, and construct infrastructure that will provide substantial additional opportunities for walking, bicycling, and other forms of active transportation
- Eligible applicants include local or regional governmental organizations, multicounty special districts, states, or tribes
- Applications are due June 17, 2024

Transportation Alternatives (TA) Program – Oklahoma Department of Transportation

- Applications due May 31, 2024
- \$34 million is available statewide. Projects require a 20 percent local match, however, for communities under 5,000 in population, only a 10 percent match is required. Maximum project award for areas with populations over 5,000 will be \$1.2 million per project. Maximum project award for areas with populations less than 5,000 will be \$700,000 per project. Applicants are limited to two project applications.
