# MINUTES

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## 1. WELCOME AND INTRODUCTIONS

Eric Pollard called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m., welcoming all in attendance.

## 2. APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES SEPTEMBER 19, 2023

Eric Pollard asked for a review of the September 19, 2023, minutes. There were no comments on the minutes.

## 3. ITEMS FOR INFORMATION ONLY

### Coalition Strategic Plan:

Eric Pollard said the Department of Energy has added grant deliverable requirements of Clean Cities Coalitions to create strategic planning documents. Mr. Pollard shared that in 2021 the coalition was redesignated by the Department of Energy for a five-year period. Mr. Pollard presented the committee with ACOG's coalition mission statement for the strategic plan.

### Funding Opportunities Update

Eric Pollard said ACOG is in the process of selecting applications for the Public Fleet Grant. There is over four million dollars of funding available for this program, which is a two-year grant cycle. ACOG will not be accepting applications next year and are working closely with applicants. Mr. Pollard said this is a funding opportunity for the public and private sector.

### EMPOWER GRANT - Workplace Charging Outreach Grant Update

David Frick said this initiative involves thirty Clean Cities Coalitions including the two coalitions in Oklahoma, and that employers were being engaged on the benefits of workplace charging.

### 2024 Policy & Legislative Priorities Discussion

Eric Pollard led discussion regarding identified legislation or policy priorities for the legislative session.
