Q: Do Attachments A, B and C count towards the 25-page limit?

A: No.

Q: Would an outside cover count towards the 25-page limit?

A: No.

Q: Would resumes of staff working on this project be included in the 25 pages, or an appendix?

A: Short staff resumes of the people that will be working on the project can be included in an appendix.

Q: Due to the fixed price contract, does the cost proposal need to be broken down by person and task?

A: Please break down the cost proposal by task.

Q: Is the Model calibrated and finalized?

A: The 2020 base of the Model will be completed by May 1, 2025. Additional modifications will be made through discussions with the chosen consultant. The 2050 Network will be dictated by the projects submitted in 2026.

Q: How much work will be required with the 2050 population, employment and land use?

A: ACOG will develop the control totals for population and employment down to the city/county level. The scenario planning will dictate where the new growth will occur.

Q: What is the scope of public engagement for the consultant?

A: The Consultant is expected to play a lead role in public engagement. This includes developing a comprehensive engagement strategy, scheduling and facilitating meetings, creating presentations and materials, and recommending both traditional and innovative outreach opportunities to ensure broad public participation. ACOG Public Information will support these efforts by providing branded templates, assisting with distribution through our communication channels, and offering guidance on messaging. All public-facing materials must be translated into the three most spoken languages in the region.
